The song satiries young cultures' obsession with popularity, even at the expense of academic success. Character seaweed isn't just the cool black kid who makes money swoon. His character marks a generational shift towards integration. Seaweed and other young black characters are marginalized at their school. They are sent to constant and undeserved detention. Authority figures such as teachers, parents, and television producers demean black characters, openly advocating racial segregation. The seaweed song begins, unable to understand why some people are so prejudiced. I can't see/why people look at me/ and only see the color of my face. And then there are those/that try to help, God knows/ But always have to put it in my place. Despite the opposition, seaweed is confident that his character will win over others. Playful seductive songs, such as darker chocolate, sweet taste, are more than just A cold. By the way, this is not the first connection between multiculturalism and food. The song features Big Blonde and Beautiful song with a similar message. The message seems to be that diversity can benefit society in the same way a multitude of flavors increase a meal. The sister of seaweed, Little Inez, was shunned during the Corny Collins dance audition. Run into the song and tell that, he exudes both confidence and frustration. Edna and her husband are a heterosexual couple, according to the story, but it's easy to think of them as a gay couple watching them on stage. With this in mind, music celebrates the combination of cultural diversity, body image and sexual orientation.
